As a parent or guardian of a player enrolled in North Whidbey Soccer Club (NWSC) programming, including Deception FC and North Whidbey Soccer Academy, I agree to follow the standards outlined in this document without exception.

- 1. I will support the efforts of NWSC coaches, officers, directors, volunteers, and others involved in the Washington Youth Soccer community.
- 2. I will not use profanity, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco at any scheduled NWSC event.
- 3. I will set an example for my player by showing good sportsmanship toward players, coaches, referees, and parents of all teams.
- 4. I will not argue a referee’s call or a coach’s decision during practices or games. Any concerns can be directed to the NWSC complaint procedure for review.
- 5. I will discuss any playing time concerns with my coach reasonably and fairly.
- 6. A parent who enters the field of play or causes a coach to receive a caution or ejection is subject to disciplinary review, which may include suspension or termination of the individual’s or family’s member status with NWSC.
- 7. I will avoid coaching from the sideline to ensure my player can implement the instructions provided by their NWSC coach. Failing to abide by this expectation is subject to disciplinary review, which may include suspension or termination of the individual’s or family’s member status with NWSC.
- 8. I will positively cheer on my player, my team, and my opponent.
- 9. I will discuss developmental concerns with my coach or a qualified officer or director of NWSC before posting disparaging information publicly, including, but not limited to, online forums, social media sites, or in-person venues.
- 10. I will allow my player to play in the way they prefer and how their coach instructs, allowing them to have fun as they engage in soccer activities.
- 11. I will follow the NWSC complaint procedure, including filing grievances. All concerns and complaints about coaches, teams, referees, or league officials should be directed to the NWSC complaint procedure and not be discussed in front of players or unaffiliated parties.
- 12. I will not bring pets to any NWSC soccer practice or game. Refusal to remove a pet may cause a practice or game to be suspended or canceled and is an action subject to disciplinary review, which may include suspension or termination of the individual’s or family’s member status with NWSC. Service animals are always welcome. Emotional support animals require previous approval by the NWSC Board of Directors.
